SGLI	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The service member's Casualty Office will certify the claim to the Office of Servicemembers' Group Life Insurance (OSGLI). The Casualty Office will work with the named beneficiary(ies) to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Complete Form SGLV 8283 Claim for Death Benefits Provide a copy of the service member's death certificate or military report of casualty

TSGLI	The service member and a licensed medical professional complete Form SGLV 8286A Claim for Death Benefits.pdf , and submit it along with supporting evidence to their uniformed service TSGLI Processing Office listed on the first page of the claim form.
